Everything you need to move your restaurant to Storekit before Oracle turns GloriaFood off. What moves across, what it costs, and the exact steps – from export to go-live.

# THE SUNSET, IN PLAIN TERMS.

Oracle acquired GloriaFood and is winding the product down. The published date is fixed: 30 April 2027. After that date, GloriaFood stops operating – admin access, online ordering, and data exports all end.

## 30 APRIL 2027

Treat it as fixed. Oracle has published the date – there is no extension to wait for.

### What ends on that date

- **Admin access** – You can no longer log in, edit menus, or manage settings.
- **Online ordering** – Your ordering widget, links, and branded apps stop taking orders.
- **Data exports** – Menus, guest lists, and order history become unrecoverable once the platform is dark.

### Why early movers win

Migrate now, not in April 2027. The earlier you move, the more time you have to test, train staff, and move regulars to your new ordering link – while GloriaFood is still live as a safety net. You can run both systems in parallel until you cut over. Restaurants that wait for sunset week will be switching in a rush, without that net, alongside everyone else who waited.

What if you miss the deadline? Storekit can still onboard you after April 2027, but GloriaFood-assisted exports may be gone – you risk losing menu and guest data you cannot recreate.

# WHAT MOVES ACROSS.

The Storekit importer connects to GloriaFood by OAuth or CSV and pulls your setup across. You review a diff of everything before a single thing goes live.

<b>Menu</b>	Categories, items, modifiers, and pricing – the full tree, not a flat list.
<b>Photos</b>	Menu photos move when GloriaFood includes them in the export. Broken or missing images are listed in the diff for you to re-upload.
<b>Opening hours</b>	Service schedules come across and can be edited before go-live.
<b>Delivery zones</b>	Zones import as configured. Adjust boundaries and fees in Storekit before you switch traffic.
<b>Promotions</b>	Active promotions are mapped to Storekit equivalents.
<b>Guest records</b>	Names, emails, and phone numbers, when present in your GloriaFood export. You approve the row count before traffic switches.
<b>Order history</b>	Past order data comes across for reporting continuity.

## **NOTHING PUBLISHES UNTIL YOU SIGN OFF.**

If we cannot match a field, we flag it in the diff and your migration concierge fixes the gap manually. You are never surprised on go-live night.

# SIX STEPS. NO DOWNTIME.

You can be live within 30 minutes – connect GloriaFood, import your menu, and take test orders the same day. Most restaurants complete the full switch within 7 days. Multi-site setups take longer; your concierge sets the date.

## 01 Start your migration

Sign up free at [dashboard.storekit.com/signup](https://dashboard.storekit.com/signup) and connect your GloriaFood account – OAuth or CSV. No card needed to start on PAYG.

---

## 02 We import your data

Menu, modifiers, photos, hours, zones, promotions, and guest records come across. A named migration concierge is assigned to your switch.

---

## 03 Review the diff

You get a line-by-line diff of menu, guests, and zones. Flagged fields are fixed by your concierge. Nothing goes live until you approve.

---

## 04 Run both in parallel

Take test orders on Storekit while GloriaFood still handles live traffic. Train staff – usually one short session covering admin login and printer routing.

---

## 05 Cut over

Flip the ordering link on your website, Google Business Profile, and socials. Your concierge schedules it for a quiet window. Open GloriaFood orders finish on GloriaFood; new orders land in Storekit.

---

## 06 First 100 orders

Your concierge stays assigned until you've taken your first 100 orders. GloriaFood stays readable in parallel until Oracle shuts it down.

# THE PRE-MIGRATION CHECKLIST.

Do these before you touch the importer – most of it in an afternoon. Items with a yellow bar are worth doing today even if you haven't picked a platform yet, because they protect your data either way.

**Export your GloriaFood data now**

Menu, guest list, and order history. While GloriaFood is live, exports work. After sunset, they don't.

**Save your menu photos**

Download a copy of every item photo so anything missing from the export can be re-uploaded.

**Note your delivery zones and fees**

Screenshot the zone map and fee bands so you can verify them against the import diff.

**List your active promotions**

Codes, discounts, and conditions – so you can confirm each one mapped correctly.

**Write down your hardware**

Printer models, kitchen screens, and your POS. Tell us on the migration form – we confirm compatibility before go-live (Lightspeed, Square tills, and other major POS systems are supported).

**Find your domain and DNS login**

Cutover means flipping your ordering link. Know who controls your website and domain before go-live night.

**List everywhere your ordering link lives**

Website, Google Business Profile, Instagram bio, Facebook, printed QR codes – each needs updating at cutover.

**Pick a quiet cutover window**

Tell your concierge your slowest service. The switch is scheduled around it.

**Book a staff session**

One short session covers admin login and printer routing. Guests see the same menu on a new link – staff impact is minimal.

# WHAT IT COSTS. WHAT IT DOESN'T.

Storekit's base tier is £0/month on the Sundown Offer – forever, not a trial. You pay per-transaction fees on orders, not a standing platform rent.

- **No setup fee** and no migration fee.
- **No platform commission** on your direct orders – card processing only.
- **No contract** no minimum term, no annual lock-in. Cancel any time.
- **No exit fee** on the base tier – we export your menu and guest data on the way out. We do not hold your book hostage.
- **No card on file** to start on PAYG. Add payment details when you need card processing or optional Storekit+ features.

### Two guarantees, in writing

Fee-match – if you find a comparable platform charging less per transaction, we match it for 12 months. Revenue-uptift – if your direct-order revenue doesn't grow in your first 90 days, we keep working with you until it does. Both are written to your account at signup; published rates can change for new signups, but your locked Sundown terms stay.

Core ordering, delivery zones, and promotions work the way they did. Then Storekit adds what GloriaFood never shipped – the parts that grow direct revenue instead of just processing it.

## AI upsells

Smart add-on prompts at checkout that lift average order value.

## Loyalty integrations

Punchh, Leat, and other providers. If you ran basic GloriaFood loyalty, we map what exported and recommend a replacement if needed.

## POS & hardware

Keep your till – we integrate with Lightspeed, Square tills, and other major POS, and route orders to supported printers and kitchen screens.

# A NAMED HUMAN WALKS YOUR SWITCH.

Support is UK-based Storekit staff – no offshore queue. Migration issues go to your named concierge first, and they stay assigned until you've taken your first 100 orders.

- **Sub-4h first reply** on weekdays for migration accounts. Most tickets close same day.
- **Saturday-night cover** Email [support@storekit.com](mailto:support@storekit.com) with URGENT in the subject – it escalates to engineering. In your first two weeks, your concierge's mobile is in the handoff doc.
- **Out-of-hours outages** Critical ordering outages escalate to on-call, with response targets in your account terms.
